Math: 3 years, Algebra 1 or higher

Science: 2 credits

(In any of the above areas or foreign language areas, philosophy)

Division 1 uses a sliding scale to match test scores and core grade-point averages (GPA).

To receive email notifications for your student:


1. Go to skyward.alpinedistrict.org

NINE STEPS FOR COMPLETING HOMEWORK

At School:

- Write Assignments in Planner
- Put in your School Bag
Assignments, Text Book, Planner, Binder
- Take School Bag Home

At Home:

- Put Name on Homework
- Complete & Check Homework
- Put Homework in Binder

Next Day:

- Take Binder Back to School
- Take Binder to Each Class
- **TURN IN** Homework

Be an Effective, Efficient Student

Get Organized:

- Don't rely on your memory
- Write down assignments and due dates in your planner at the end of each period

Manage Your Time:

- Allow plenty of time to complete assignments
- Have a set time for homework
- Write a schedule for homework, studying and other activities
- Look ahead in your planner often.

Manage Your Space:

- Organize your locker
- Keep a list of what to bring home in your locker
- Clean your locker, backpack, & binder weekly
