The Camp

To make sure that your students are safe during this activity, we ask that you carefully read and sign this paper. While the National Archery in the Schools Program has a better safety record than most other physical activities, there is always a chance for injury. However, archery has fewer injuries than any of the "ball sports", with the exception of table tennis. Injuries and accidents can be nearly eliminated when safety rules are followed. Students will show mastery of the safety rules and procedures **prior** to using any archery equipment. Students will be taught proper form, safety rules and general knowledge of the equipment. Students will be expected to adhere to all safety rules and follow guidelines on care of the equipment. Anyone ignoring or not following expectations may be sidelined from the activity until sufficient retraining has occurred to insure everyone's safety.

Come join Frontier Middle School's fastest growing and most successful sport. We are excited to offer a summer camp that will help improve skills, safety and knowledge of shooting a bow. - * If your student is new to the program then he/ she will spend the first two days learning all the safety, skills and whistle commands to safely shoot a bow
- * On the Last day of the Camp we will hold a small tournament and have awards for the top 3 shoot.
